

LOCAL CIRCUIT AV2: TROTTISCLIFFE & RYARSH

Linked churches:

Addington (start and finish)

Trottiscliffe (Direction 18)

Ryarsh (Direction 34A: Detour - see Appendix)

Roads and hindrances:

There are few roads, and the only one of any significance (Addington Lane – Direction 11) is short and easily manageable with the help of a grass verge – though it might be sensible to cross early to the left-hand side towards the end, for a good sightline.

There are no hindrances of note.

Notes taken: May and June 2015

The start and finish is at Addington Church (ME19 5BQ).

1		With your back to the gate of Addington Church, facing north, turn left immediately and go down the narrow track. When	653 588	
2	_	you reach a metalled driveway, continue straight across it.		
2	2	Reach the cricket field and turn left to walk, clockwise, around it.		
3	3	Ignore the footbridge on the left and continue around the cricket boundary.		
4	5	Go left away from the cricket boundary, keeping the Village Hall (and beyond it the cricket pavilion) to your right and a store building to your left, pass a green gate, and continue along the left-hand edge of the car park towards the road.		
5	6	Cross the road and take the footpath immediately opposite. (There is a warning sign which implies that you should not, but it is presumably aimed not at you, but at people who might behave irresponsibly around the works ahead: the path, though sometimes overgrown and tricky, is clearly a signposted right of way.)		
6	7	Go straight on, towards the motorway, along a narrow path with a barbed-wire fence on your right.		
7	9	Continue ahead as the works access road comes in from the left.		
8	10	Go through the subway under the motorway, and immediately afterwards turn left up steep steps. Continue up ahead (now briefly following the Wealdway), between green posts and onwards with a fence on your left.		
9	11	Cross the works road at an angled crossing and continue in the same direction along a narrow path with fences on both sides.

10	12	Approaching another works road at a similar angle, this time		
		follow the path opposite almost at right-angles to the road, and		
		do not get drawn into the works forecourt to the right of it.		
11	13	Turn right along the main road, continuing with the		
		Wealdway.		
12	17	[Map point] Just before the road swings to the right, turn left		0.86
		(Woodgate Road, briefly). After about 20 yds., turn left again,		
		off the road and up steps. [!!F!!] Then carry straight on along a		
		footpath (still the Wealdway) across a large field. Looking at		
		the poles supporting the power lines, you pass between the		
		third and the fourth, counting from the left.		
13	21	[!!F!!] Reaching a MKG, turn half-left, aiming a little to the right	654 598	
		of Trottiscliffe Church, which can be seen nestling beneath the		
		downs in the distance.		
14	25	[!!F!!] Go through a gap in the hedge and straight on to		
		converge on the line of the field edge and ditch at the bottom		
		on the left. (There is currently a slight discrepancy between the		
		mapped and waymarked line and the reality on the ground:		
		hence the waymark in the hedge about 25 yds. further to the		
		right! So long as you converge on the the ditch below it would		
		not seem to matter.)		
15	28	[!!F!!] Cross the ditch and continue ahead over the next field,		
		soon going gently downhill.		
16	34	Reaching the road, turn left and then swing right with it.		
17	35	At the road junction go straight ahead.		
18	36	As the road swings left next to Trottiscliffe Church , go right		1.74
		instead, up the steep and narrow track into trees.		
19	37	[!!F!!] After a brief climb up this track, emerge at the start of a		
		large field, and continue ahead in the same direction, gently		
20		uphill.		
20	42	Go across the road and continue along the cul-de-sac opposite.		
21	43	After a small parking area on the left, go ahead along the track,		
		past the vehicle gate.		
22	46	Go straight ahead along the right-hand side of a field.		
23	48	Follow the rightward swing in the track, and very soon merge		
2.4		into the Wealdway as it comes in from the left.		
24	49	Ignore the private access road on the left and pass the Long		
25		Barrow monument on the right.		
25	51	When the main path swings decisively to the right, instead go		
		slightly left, downhill along a clear but narrow and currently		
26		unmarked track.		
26	52	Merge left into a broader track, which then soon swings right		
		again. Then, faced with the choice of two MKGs, go through		
		the one to the left (turning away from the Wealdway, which		
		goes straight on. Having made this left turn, go ahead along a		
27		wide open passageway between fenced fields.	/FE / ^ /	2 ==
	55	Go straight ahead into the wood.	657 606	2.55
28	58	Fork right, as waymarked.

29	61	Go to the left through a gap beside a redundant stile, and then		
		over two little footbridges.		
30	65	[Map point] Emerge from the trees at a road junction and go		
		half-right along Chapel Street.		
31	71	Swing to the right with Chapel Street and follow it down to the	669 602	
		major road ahead.		
32	75	Cross the main road to the Duke of Wellington, and then turn		
		left along Old School Lane, so that you are continuing along the		2.52
		original direction of Chapel Street. Swing first right then left		3.53
		with the road.		
33	81	Go over the motorway and continue straight ahead along the		
		narrow track.		
34	85	Turn right on to a cross path.		
		To pricit Paranch Change more digrant instead to the Detorn in the		
		[To visit Ryarsh Church , now divert instead to the Detour in the Appendix.]		
35	86	Go ahead along the roadway as it merges from the left.		
36	90	Cross the road and continue ahead along the footpath opposite.		4.17
37	91	Go through the kissing gate and continue ahead along the left-

38	93	[!!F!!] At the far corner, go through the MKG and embark on		
		the crossing of a stretch of open heathland, guided, if it is		
		visible, by a faint track. To begin with head across very slightly		
		to the right, not quite parallel to the fence on the right but		
		edging towards it (though it will turn away before you reach		
		it).		
39	85	[!!F!!] At the top of the ridge, such as it is, merge with another		
		faint track, to go slightly further to the right. (If this track is not		
		visible, take your direction from a newly appeared fence on the		
		right. On this occasion you will be converging on this, just to		
		the right of a clump of trees ahead.)		
40	96	Continue ahead through the right-hand fringe of those trees,		
		and finally converge on the fence to the right, at a MKG.		
41	97	[Map point] Go through the MKG and across the golf course	663 592	
		(more or less parallel to the motorway on the right), aiming		
		about 50 yds. to right of a dark brown building with a red-tiled

42	101	Passing the building, leave the golf course through a gap in the		4.66

49	113	Arrive at Addington Church , the starting point of the walk.	653 588	5.23

34A	0	Instead of turning right on to the cross path, carry straight on.		0.00
		The path is currently very overgrown, but harmlessly so.		
		Ryarsh Church will appear on the left.		
34B	1	On leaving the church turn half-right along the roadway.		
34C	Follow the road as it swings leftwards, rejoining the main route as it merges from the right at Direction 35.			0.13
		Add 2 minutes to subsequent total times and 0.08 miles to cumulative distances.		

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FOR THOSE WHO WALK WITH THEIR DOGS

I do not venture to give advice about walking with your dog. As well as the joys, you will be well aware of the issues involved, and particularly that relationships between dogs and other countryside animals potentially involve mutual suspicion, or worse.

But what this footnote does try to do, in response to requests, is to give some indication of the nature of the walk from a dog's point of view, to enable you to decide whether it is suitable.

The percentage distances on the right (on the next page) should be self-explanatory.

The information in the middle column may look a bit cluttered, but I think it should enable you (if the detail is of interest) to mark up within a few minutes a print-out of the walk notes, so that you have some idea what might be round the next corner.

The risk in all this is that **things change so quickly** in the agricultural working world; and what I describe might become misleading after subsequent changes. I have done my best, but there is no guarantee that you will find the information up to date!
