


LOCAL CIRCUIT GS1: PARKWOOD AND BREDHURST - 5.74 miles

Linked churches:

Hempstead (start and finish)

Wigmore (Direction 11)

Parkwood (19)

Bredhurst (41)

Roads and hindrances:

There are some major roads to cross, all requiring simply the usual amount of caution.

Navigation through the woods at Directions 53-60 needs some care, but walking in as straight a line as possible will ensure a safe arrival at the bottom of Cedar Grove.

The start and finish is at All Saints Church, Hempstead - 169 Hempstead Road, ME7 3QG.

FOR THOSE WHO WALK WITH THEIR DOGS

I do not venture to give advice about walking with your dog. As well as the joys, you will be well aware of the issues involved, and particularly that relationships between dogs and other countryside animals potentially involve mutual suspicion, or worse.

But what this footnote does try to do, in response to requests, is to give some indication of the nature of the walk from a dog's point of view, to enable you to decide whether it is suitable.

The percentage distances on the right (on the next page) should be self-explanatory.

The information in the middle column may look a bit cluttered, but I think it should enable you (if the detail is of interest) to mark up within a few minutes a print-out of the walk notes, so that you have some idea what might be round the next corner.

The risk in all this is that <u>things change so quickly</u> in the agricultural working world; and what I describe might become misleading after subsequent changes. I have done my best, but there is no guarantee that you will find the information up to date!

STILES: There are currently no stiles on this walk.
