Memory Verse

1 John 3 v 1

A question to ask each other

Family Fun Together

Let's recap: In this passage, John recaps all the points he has made earlier in his epistle (letter) but much more quickly.

Play a game of 'guess the favourite book or film'. Each person picks a favourite story. They must then try to act out the whole thing as a super-fast recap! Can everybody else still work out what the story is?

Connect with God Together

This passage reminds us that there is nothing in the world that we cannot overcome because of our faith.

Spend some time worshipping and celebrating this amazing truth together. Give any worries or concerns to God in prayer and then enjoy dancing, singing and praising God with freedom and joy!



World Conquerors challenge

This passage promises that there is nothing in the world that we cannot overcome (and Jesus himself said he had overcome the world), but there are many things happening in the world that sadden God. War, sickness, hunger and homelessness – none of these things were part of God's perfect plan for the world. Spend some time praying together for things you see in the world that need conquering!
